

# Proposition 107: End Government Quotas, End Race Preferences, End Reverse Discrimination

The state shall not grant preferential treatment to or discriminate against any individual or group on the basis of race, sex, color, ethnicity, or national origin in the operation of public employment, public education, or public contracting.

## **Vote YES on Prop. 107**

Proposition 107 is a proposed constitutional amendment placed on the November ballot by the legislature that will prohibit the state from granting preferential treatment based on skin color or gender in 3 specific areas: public employment, public contracting and public education.

### Proposition 107...

- Reflects the colorblind language of the 1964 Civil Rights Act -- because *equal* treatment, NOT *preferential* treatment, is the essence of civil rights.
- Eliminates Affirmative Action preferences for groups of individuals based on race or sex in the operation of public employment, university admissions, and public contracting.
- Bans government quotas, set-aside programs, and reverse discrimination so that every person has a fair chance to compete for good paying jobs and college admissions.

Sadly, opponents of Proposition 107 have chosen fear as their tool to deceive you. Radical groups like ACORN and other far left groups have launched a campaign of misinformation. Experiences in the five states where voters have already banned "affirmative action" - race and gender preferences - have proven that claims by opponents of Prop 107 are completely false.

### Proposition 107 does not...

- Affect public health facilities, public health or safety programs, fair housing programs or private scholarships.
- Eliminate outreach or true equal opportunity programs.
- Eliminate girls sports programs, domestic violence shelters, or ANY other programs unrelated to public hiring, public contracting or equal access to public education.
